



## **IDP Assessor/Psychotherapist** **(Full-time)**

Jefferson County's Mental Health Division seeks a knowledgeable, organized, and compassionate individual to take on the role as IDP Assessor/Psychotherapist. This position will focus on completing assessments for the Intoxicated Driver Program (IDP), overseeing the entire program to assist clients and remain in compliance with the policies and procedures created from the program, and will provide Mental Health Intervention services.

To be successful in this position, the main responsibilities and tasks will include the following:

- Develop appropriate Driver Safety Plan (DSP) based on client's needs.
- Maintain monthly contact with DSP Providers
- Submits compliance reports
- Performs bio-psycho-social assessment for clients
- Diagnoses clients based on the set standards
- Develops clinical treatment plan
- Variety of other necessary tasks

Starting wage = \$27.55/hour

Minimum Requirements: Master's Degree in Social Work or Counseling and related experience, Licensed Professional Counselor or Clinical Social Worker, or equivalent combination of education and experience, required. One year related experience, Substance Abuse Counseling Licensure and Trauma Informed Care training, preferred.
