Briarpatch Youth Services has an exciting job opportunity for a skilled professional. The agency is a dynamic non-profit community organization that has served Dane County since 1971. Briarpatch provides shelter, counseling, support, outreach, employment, and supervision services to more than 3,000 runaway, homeless, at-risk, and court-involved youth annually.

Job Title:	Bi-lingual Youth Counselor / Case Manager
Description:	Persons in this position serve youth and families in the Briarpatch Runaway & Homeless Youth (RHY) Program.
Qualifications:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Requires a Bachelor’s Degree in human services or a related field from an accredited college or university; or, the equivalent of two (2) years of full-time experience working in a human services or youth development setting. • Fluency in English and Spanish is required. • Applicants should possess an understanding of Trauma Informed Care, Positive Youth Development, and Harm Reduction.
Duties & Responsibilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides intake assessment, counseling, and case management services to youth and their families. • May occasionally oversee the daily living activities of youth staying in the agency's youth shelter. • Establishes and maintains client files; documents client contacts and completes case related documentation in accordance with RHY Program and agency standards. • Provides assistance and support to volunteers, interns and other RHY staff. • Maintains a working knowledge of RHY Program and agency policies and procedures. • Participates in the RHY Program on-call staff rotation. • Answers the RHY Program help-line in English and Spanish as necessary. • Performs other reasonable and related duties as assigned.
Hours:	This is a full-time 40 hour per week position. Typical work hours are between 9:00am and 8:00pm Monday through Friday. On-call counselor hours include weekend and overnight coverage with additional compensation provided.
Transportation:	A valid driver's license in good standing with auto insurance is preferred.
Compensation Package:	Starting pay is \$37,440 annually. A higher starting wage is available for persons with a master's degree in a human services field and/or 5 plus years of experience working with youth. Benefits include: health, dental, life, & disability insurance; paid holidays; SEP/403B plan; flex spending account; mileage reimbursement; and generous paid time off.
